## Technology

The passage of the operating levy by our community has given many advantages to our students this year, one of which was the partial funding of the Library Connectivity Project. The remainder of the monies for this project were provided by a grant funded through the Education Enhancement Partnership Funds for Library Automation, coordinated through Mr . Lambes, Mr. Hexamer, and Mrs. Little. This project enabled the Northwest High School library to become automated. A bar coding system was installed that allowed students to check out books and materials more efficiently.

With money from the operating levy, the board purchased a Power Mac and a Pentium PC. These computers include word processors, spread sheets, money management systems, desk top publishing capabilities, and much more. Students were able to get valuable technological experience by becoming familiar with these computers.
