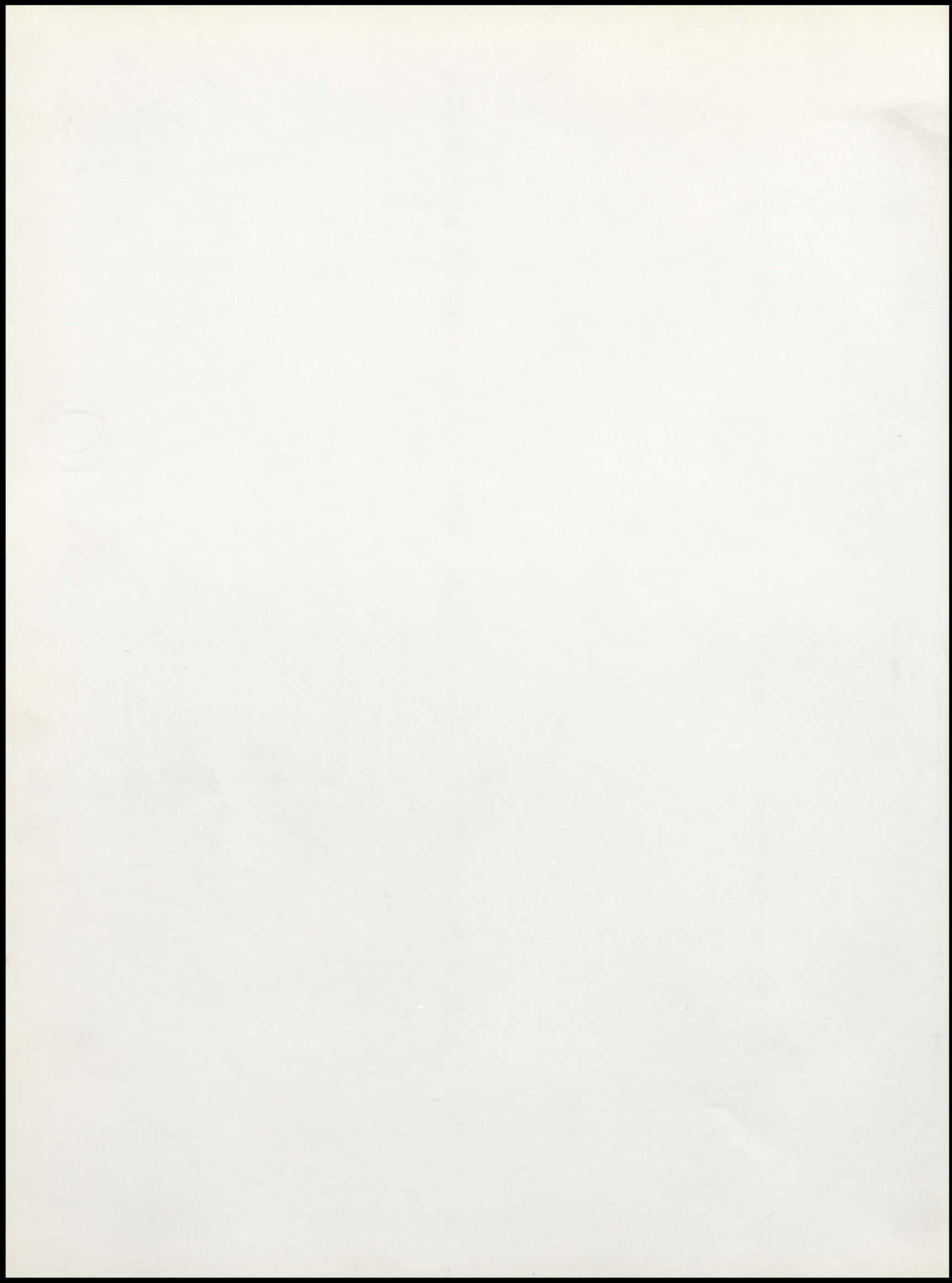

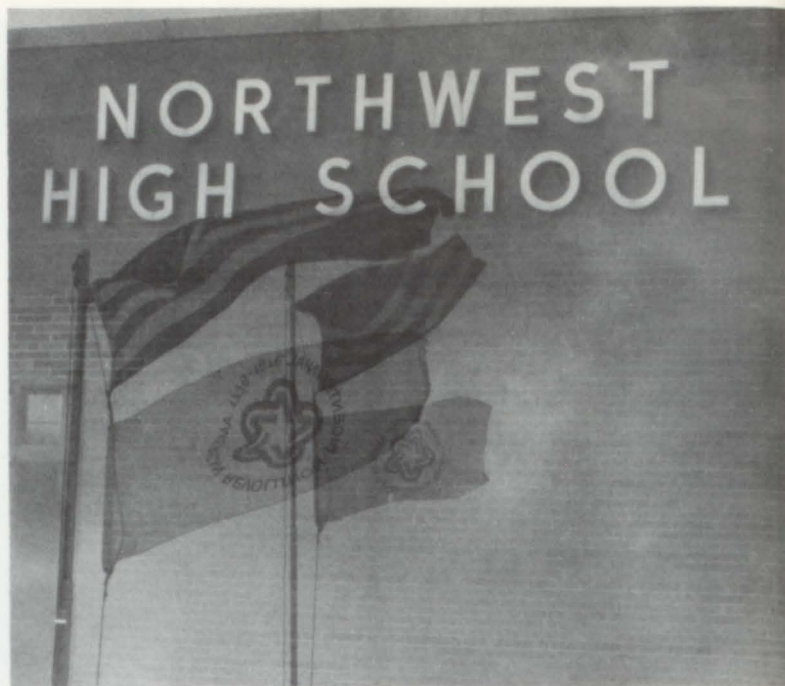


Near the front doors of Northwest High School, a large rock has been placed. On the rock is a bronze plaque which reads:

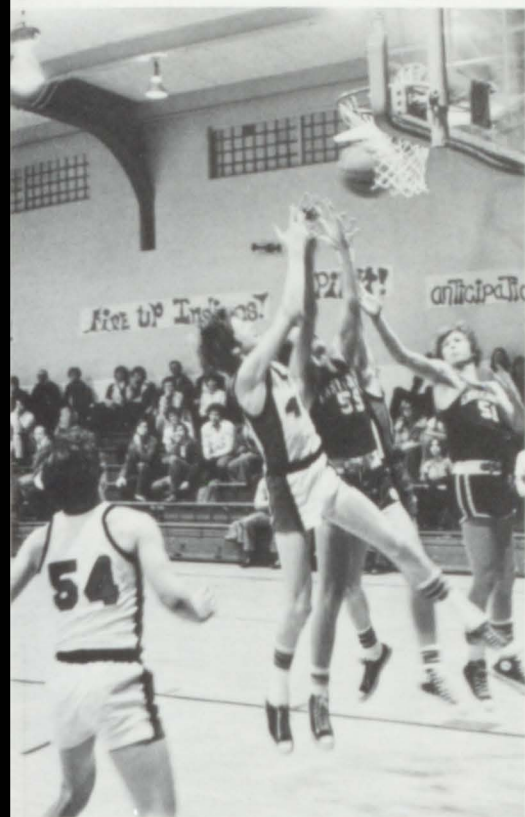

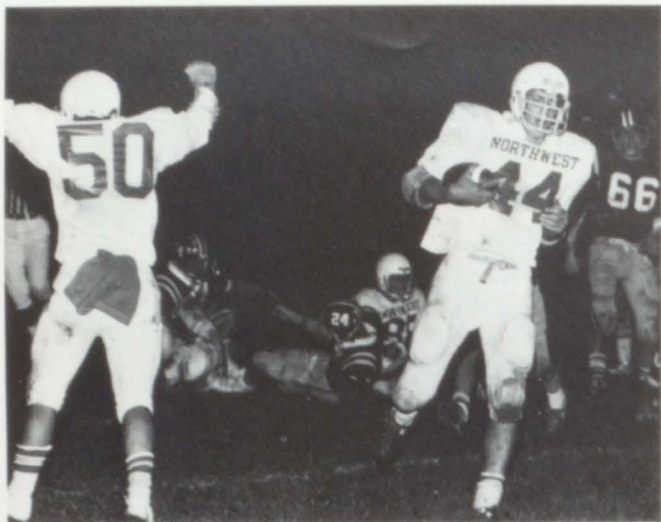

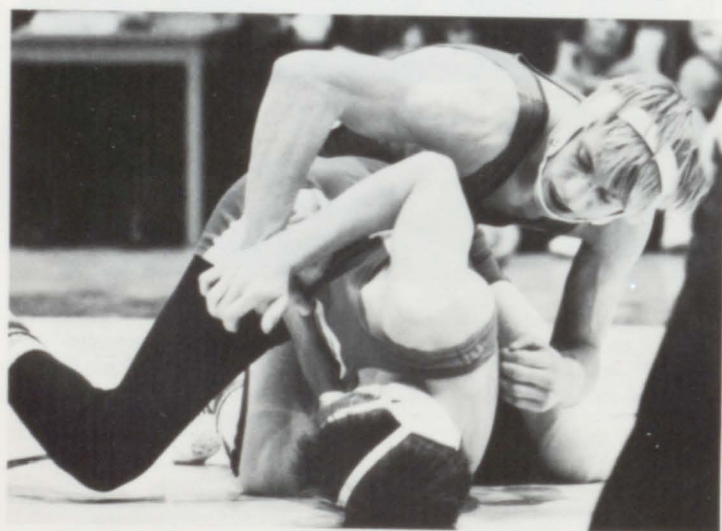

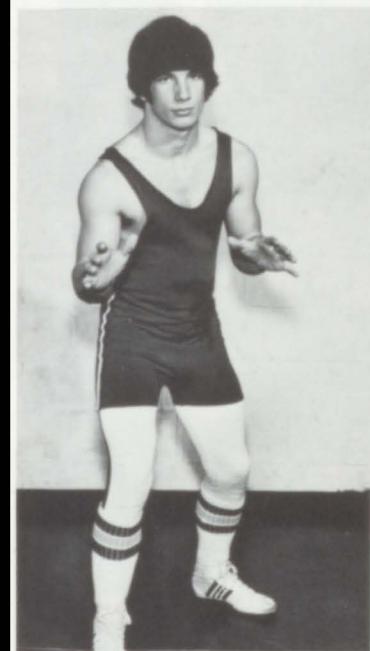

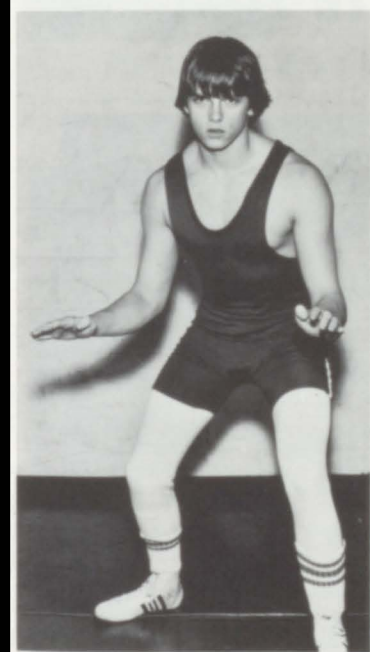

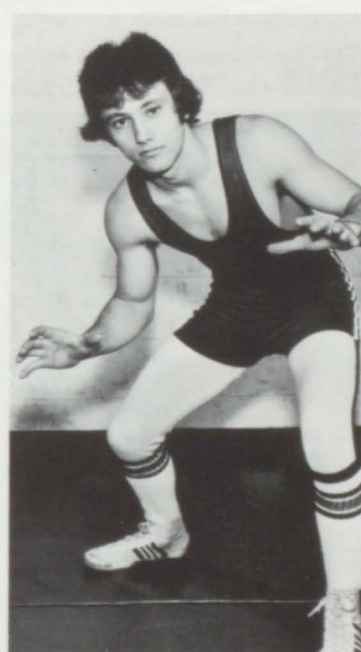

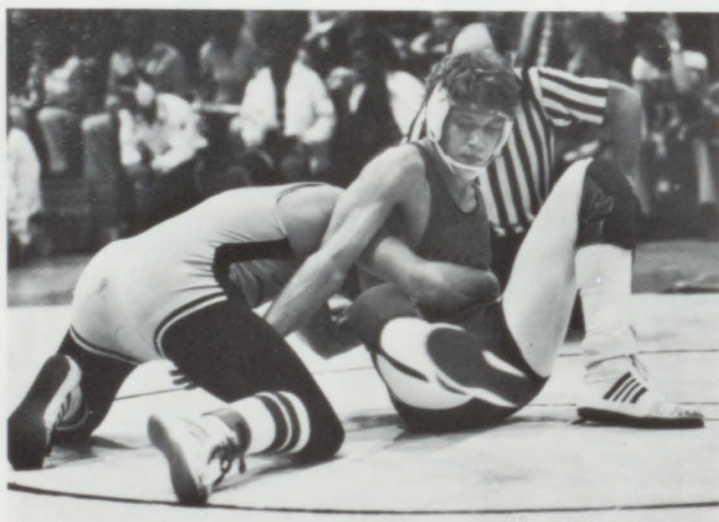

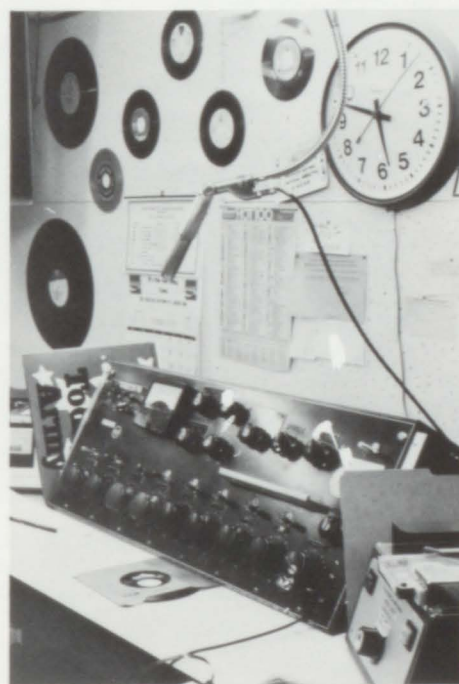

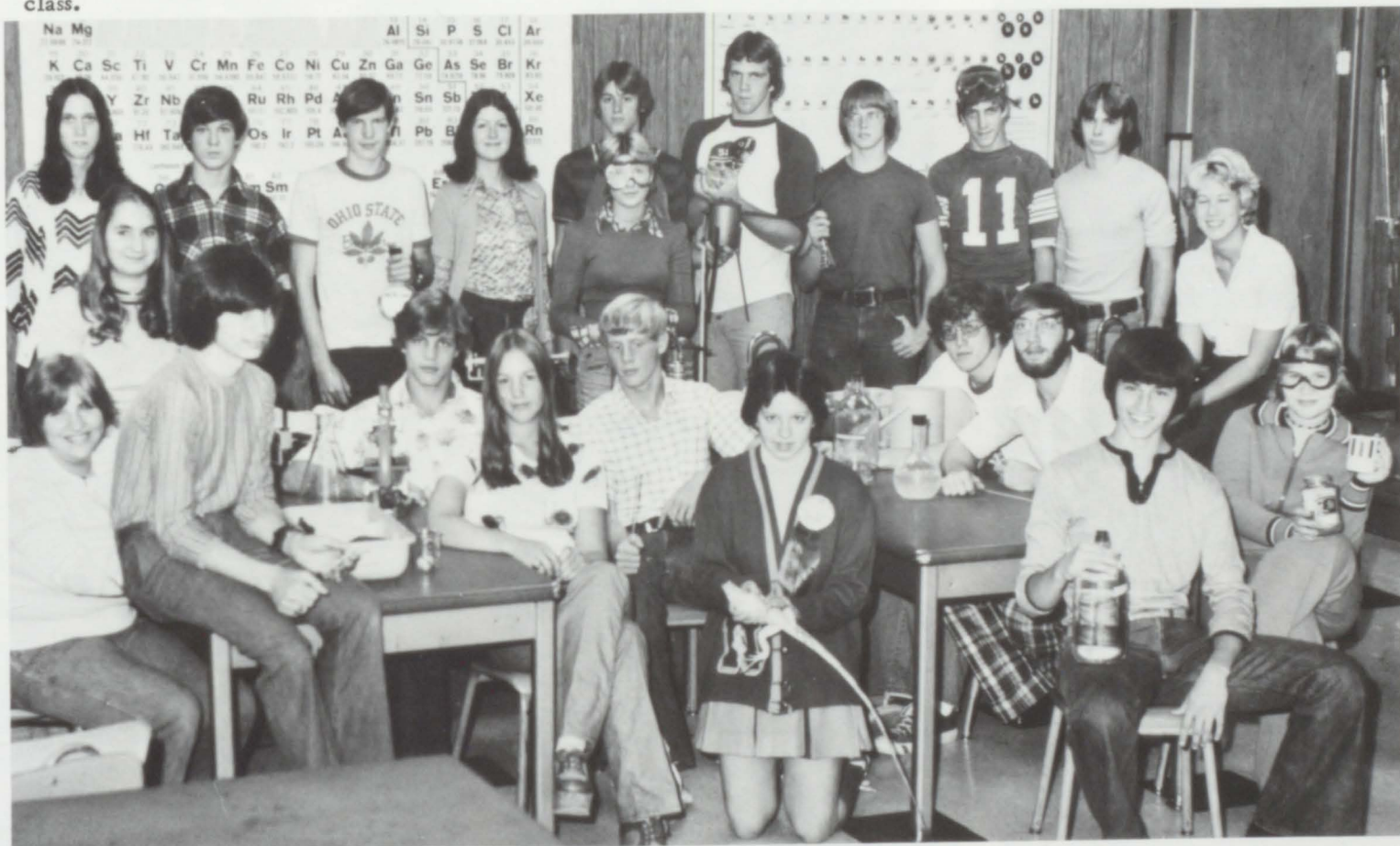

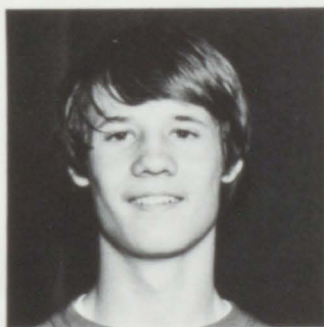

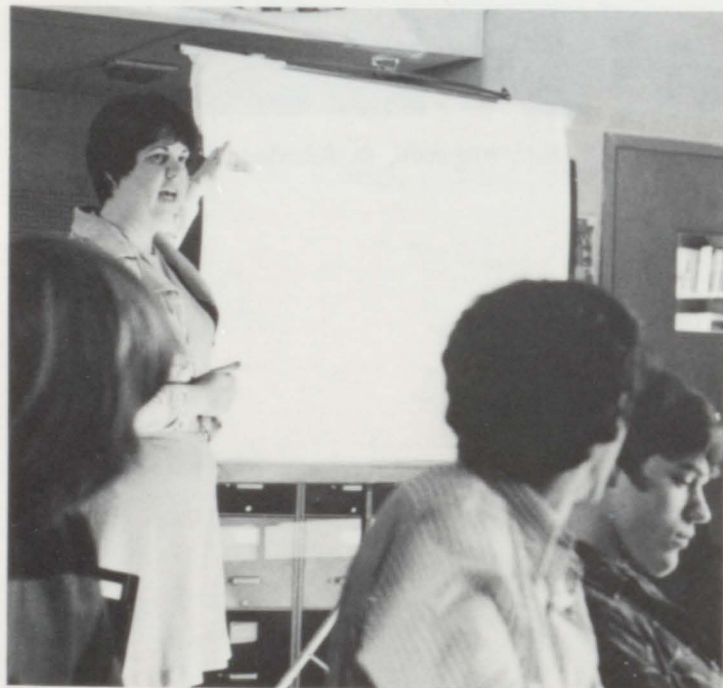

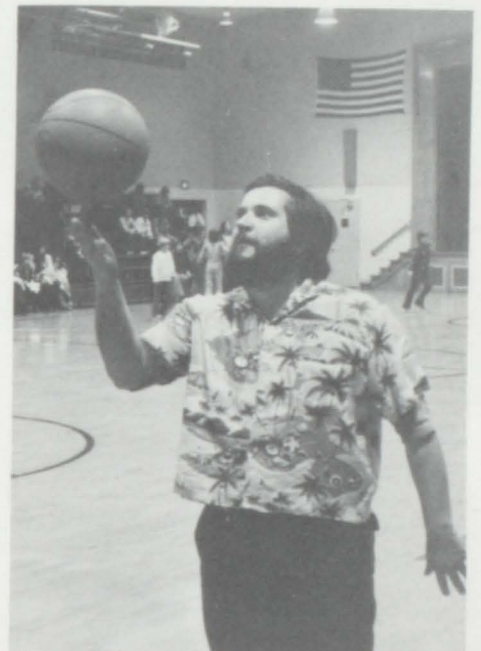
