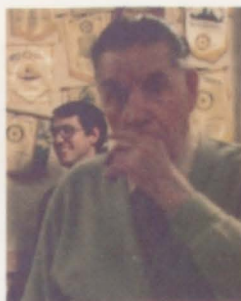
There are few organizations or individuals who can boast of giving 100% to the betterment of their schools and community like this club has always done.

Among the many outstanding contributions they make are:

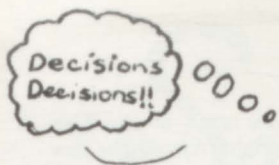
1. Sponsorship of the Honor's Banquet

How well these words fit Mr. Del Halpin, a former teacher and coach at NHS.

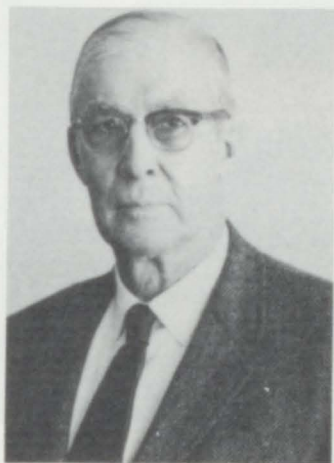
Mr. Halpin's life touched many lives and will continue to touch lives as long as there is an NHS. His shadow will be ever present and it is a welcome shadow.

Mr. Halpin passed away this past August, but his shadow will be ever present in our halls and memories.

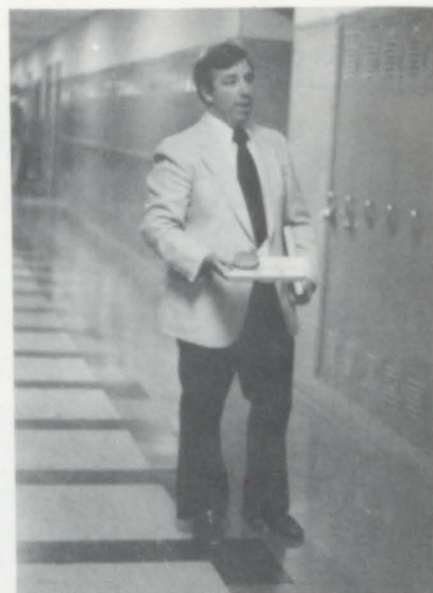
