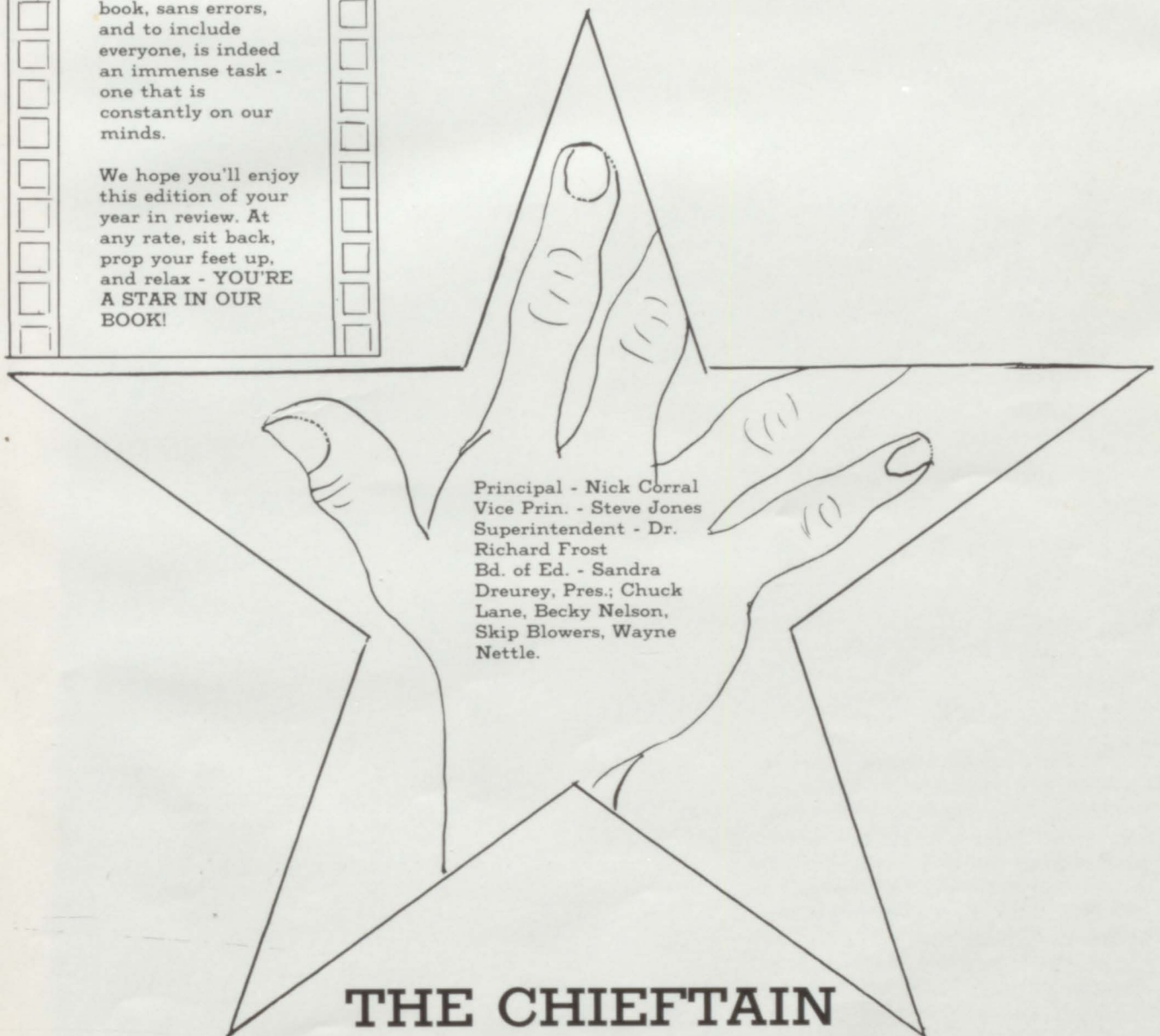
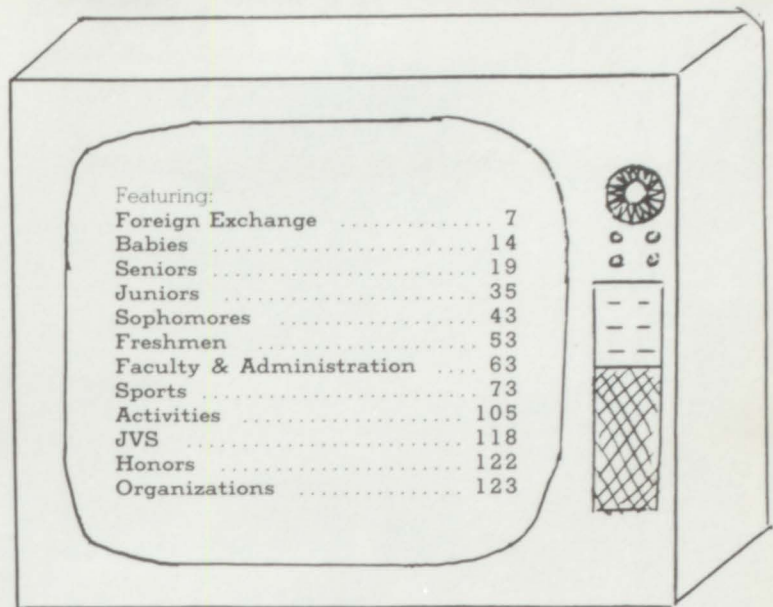


The theme for this year's Chieftain is centered around the ever popular media theme - including films, TV shows, video games, radio, etc.

To put together a book, sans errors, and to include everyone, is indeed an immense task - one that is constantly on our minds.

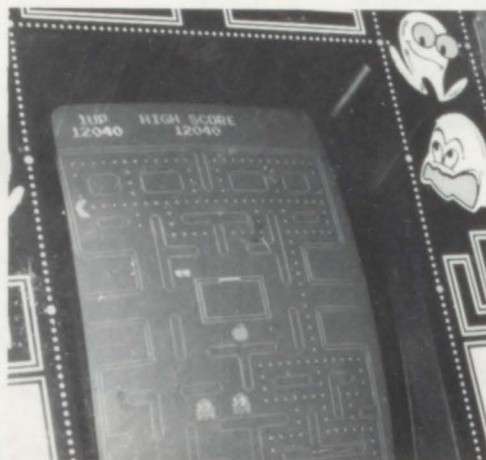

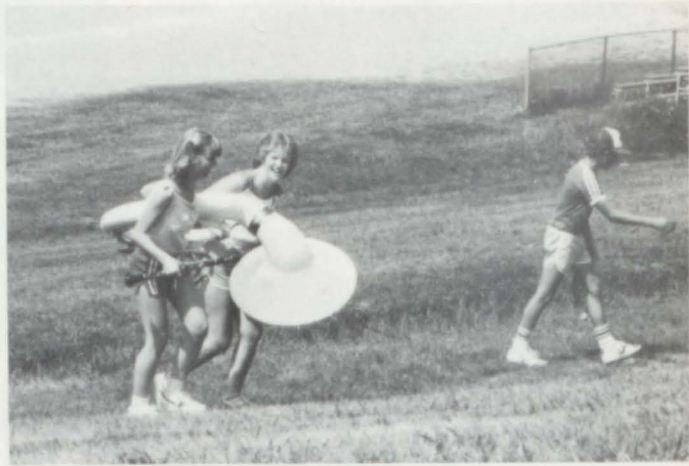

Being a foreign exchange student is something I will never forget. Besides meeting new people and finding another home half way across the ocean, you learn to stand on your own two feet.

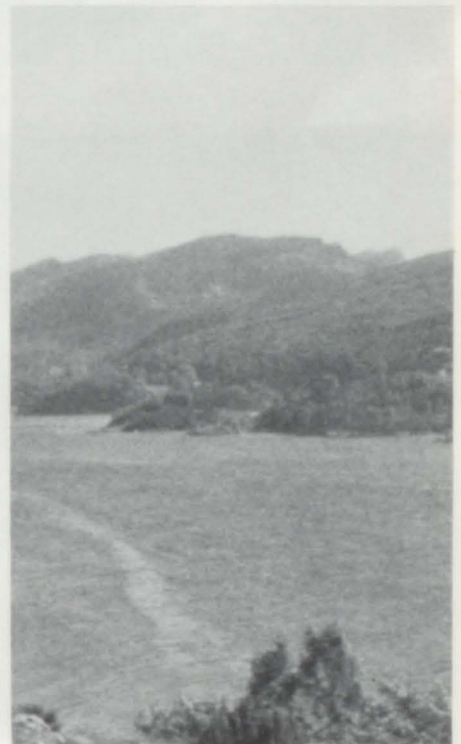

Although I had to learn a different language, I really had no major problems. I grew up and I hope that anyone who has the chance, will become a foreign exchange student, because it's worth it!

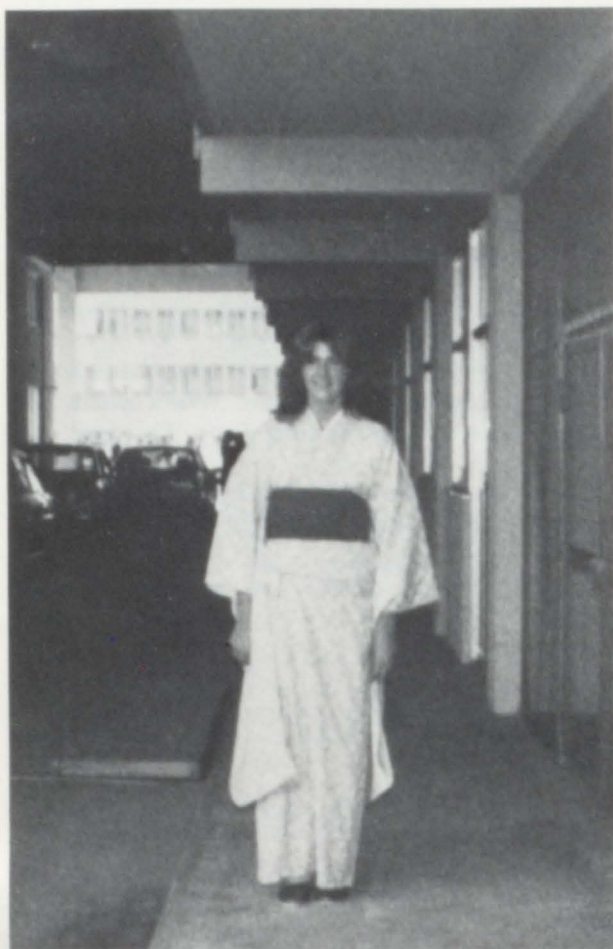

# OHIO (HELLO) FROM JAPAN

Dear Friends,

I would like to thank you for all the wonderful memories you've given me at Northwest High School, and especially for giving me the opportunity to go to Japan. I have been here only a short time now, but am enjoying every minute of it. I can't believe I am actually here in Japan, and experiencing so many wonderful, new things. These things which I am learning and seeing will stay with me forever. This time spent away from home and friends is teaching me many things - how to deal with all types of people, and accepting different points of views. such as customs, culture, language, and foods, I am also learning much about myself as a person, and what it means to be a true American. I wish you all could get the chance to do something like this.

The climate in Matsuyama, the city in which I live, is very similar to Ohio's, but from May to September, it is very hot and humid, with the rainy season in June. Typhoon season is August, and I was in four typhoons. It cools off in November, and winter gets down to about 40°(F). That's pretty cold when there is no heat in schools or homes. Japan is about the size of California, with half as many people in the United States. That makes for very crowded conditions. Homes and buildings are very close together and streets are very narrow. "Backyards" are unheard of!!

I am attending Shinonome High School. It is a private, protestant all girl's school. There are about twelve hundred students. Uniforms are worn to school six days a week. Most girls study often because classes and entrance exams are difficult. But being an exchange student is much easier. Some of my classes include cooking, music, English, craft, brush-writing, dance, and of course Japanese! There are many rules the girls must obey. For example, no make-up, nail polish, perms, shopping after school, and no boyfriends. But once again, being an exchange student has its advantages, and I break about all the rules.

Since I've arrived in Japan, I've done much travelling. Two of my favorite cities (so far) have been Hiroshima and Tokyo. In Hiroshima, I visited the Memorial Museum, Peace Park, and the A-Bomb dome. These things made me realize what a horrible mistake the A-bomb is. It was so unreal, the amount of damage it did. I had tears in my eyes.

Many people ask about Japanese food - I love it! I've even become a pro at chopsticks. Some of my favorites are: sushi (vinegared rice with raw fish wrapped in seaweed), okonomiyaki (cabbage pancakes with squid, octopus, shrimp or meat), tempura (deep fried foods), and sukiyaki (tofu, meat, and cabbage dipped in egg yolk.) But my favorite is octopus and squid, specially prepared, and of course, rice.

One of the girls I spend time with is another exchange student from Detroit. One of our favorite things to do on a Saturday night is to go to Dogo Hot Springs, where we take a PUBLIC BATH! Then we go to a coffee shop. I don't really care for the Japanese style toilets.

I'm honestly having a great time over here. If any of you ever get the chance to do something different like this, please do it! There are so many opportunities within our grasp-if only we would try . . . Well, I wish the best of luck to you all in the years to come. As we say in Japan, "Gan-bate."

Hi everyone,

I really like it here in Japan. I've met many nice people.

The town I'm living in is Kashima. It has really small roads, and everyone drives Hondas and Toyotas.

My host father is a Buddhist priest and also owns a kindergarten. There are children around most of the day. He is also a fifth degree black belt. I will be staying with them until January.

Every morning I get up at 7:00 and leave at 8:00 to walk to school. I get home about 6:30 or 7:00 at night. We have classes on Saturday morning from 8:30-12:30. I have to wear a uniform. My school is co-ed, but my classes aren't. The students are shy at first, but then they are really friendly. The teachers are very helpful.

After school I have Kendo Club and Karate. Kendo is the ancient art of sword fighting, but we use bamboo poles. I wear a special uniform and a mask. Karate is very tiring - we have to run two miles through the streets - barefoot! I got to try Sumo wrestling and refereed some boys' matches.

The food here is good. I've had lots of soup, rice, and cold tea. Also octopus, squid, sushi, seaweed, and raw fish. You always eat first and then ask what it is.

I've seen Chinese and French movies with Japanese subtitles. My sister and I were on TV on an exercise program with 2,500 people.

The Rotary is really great-they make sure I have everything I need. I met some exchange students from Australia. I enjoy hearing about Northwest. I'm glad the football and cross country teams are doing so well.

An English professor at Clemson University says astetismus, a classical literary

term that means a deliberate or accidental misunderstanding of words, is what kept the 407th Mobile Army Surgical Hospital rolling for 11 years.

"They frequently use straight puns, substituting one word for another. But M\*A\*S\*H's real trademark is a specialty called astetismus," says Corinne Sawyer, who has been a "M\*A\*S\*H" scholar for

three years and a fan since the first show in 1972.

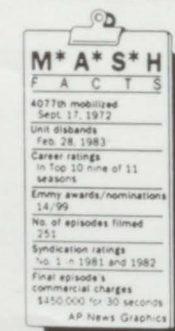
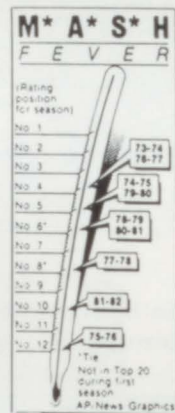
For example, Col. Flagg, a slightly cracked military intelligence officer, says "I'm off," Col. Sherman Potter, the 407th's commanding officer, replies, "I couldn't have said it better myself."

Or Hawkeye Pierce, a surgeon, seeing a frightened young

soldier crouched in a corner with a kitten, asks, "What's his name?" Fr. Mulcahy answers, "Fluffy."

THEN THERE'S the type of pun where the speaker establishes and then abruptly changes the meaning of the word halfway through a sen-

## Hawkeye not anti-war, Alda says

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Hawkeye Pierce, the soulful surgeon on "M\*A\*S\*H," was a symbol of the insanity of war, according to the show's producer and many of its fans. But Alan Alda, who played the character for 11 years, disagrees.

"Hawkeye spoke for the insanity of war, the horrible contradiction of patching up young men in order to let them go out and kill again and possibly be wounded or die on the second trip to the hospital," said Bert Metcalfe, the executive producer of "M\*A\*S\*H," which airs its last episode tonight after 251 episodes.

But Alda, who played Hawkeye from beginning to

end, says he never intended for the character to be an anti-war symbol.

"I don't think he symbolized anything," Alda said. "I might seem disingenuous saying this, but I do believe it. Basically, we wanted to humanize the experience of war. I think that had an effect on the audience."

WILL HE MISS Hawkeye? "I don't think so," he said at first, then reconsidered after thinking about the combat boots Hawkeye wore. "I took the boots home with me and I look at them and I get touched. There's something that I'll miss about that character."

"When I finished shooting, I really was very churned up," he said. "That's partly why it's been hard for me to find time to

talk about it, because I really don't want to talk about it."

Alda said he won't get involved in another series, except perhaps as a creative consultant. In the works, for instance, is a series based on "The Four Seasons," the 1981 movie Alda wrote, starred in and directed.

Alda said he'll supervise the series about mid-life crises in the lives of four couples. He has more films to make, too. But for the time being, he said he feels completely fulfilled.

"I'm a very lucky man. I've got everything I want, everything I possibly could want. Now that I don't have to shoot 12 hours a day, I have time to really balance my life, to do the regular, mundane things people do," Alda said. "I love it. I'm very happy."

## Real unit had no hanky-panky

OMAHA, Neb. (AP) — Being a surgeon during the Korean War was just as grim as portrayed by actors on television's long-running "M\*A\*S\*H" series, but it had little of the "hanky-panky" that lightened the episodes, says one doctor who served in the conflict.

"During all of the time I was in Korea, I never had one drink," said Robert Koefoot, a Grand Island physician who was one of eight surgeons in the 807th Mobile Army Surgical Hospital unit. "I did not see one bottle of beer. There was no drinking. There was no hanky-panky. There was nothing but work."

Koefoot, now a member of

the University of Nebraska Board of Regents, said his unit had similarities and differences when compared to Hollywood's 407th "M\*A\*S\*H."

Instead of the TV show's stationary tent village, Koefoot said his unit operated from vacant buildings during June and October of 1950.

"WE HAD GOOD, well-trained fellows," he said of the surgeons. "We always felt if the soldiers got to our unit we should save 98 percent of them. Young, healthy adults can tolerate practically anything if they receive the proper treatment."

He said his patients included Korean soldiers from both

sides, civilians, Turks, Greeks, British and French soldiers in addition to Americans.

There was little sentimentality when people left his unit, Koefoot said. They were simply reassigned, first to an evacuation hospital and later to other posts.

But some of the surgeons still keep in touch, he said.

Although Koefoot didn't regularly watch the program, he said he understands how the situation would appeal to filmmakers.

"I certainly could see why they would be interested," he said. "You become very close. We lived together, slept together. A close-knit group? You bet."
