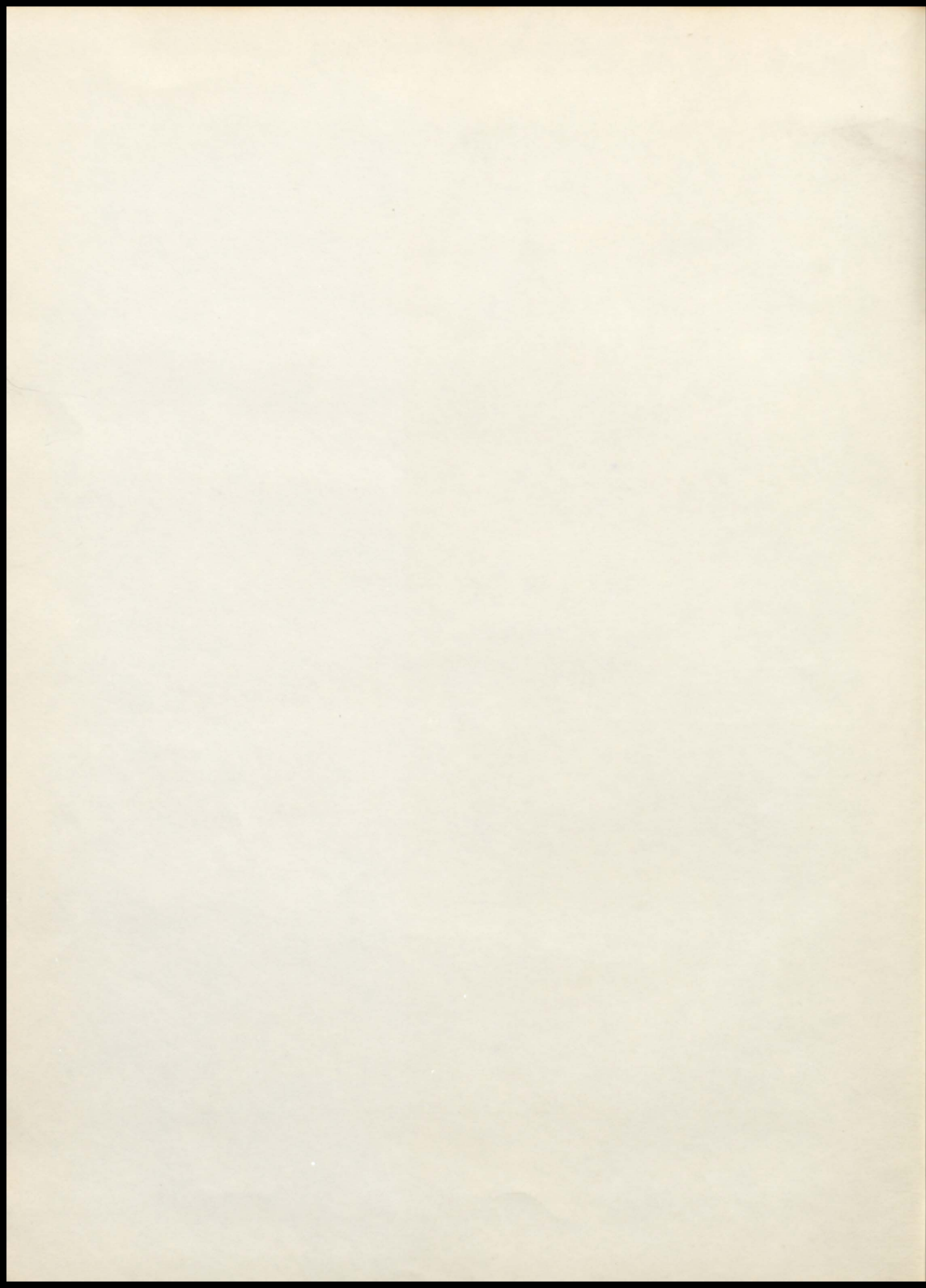


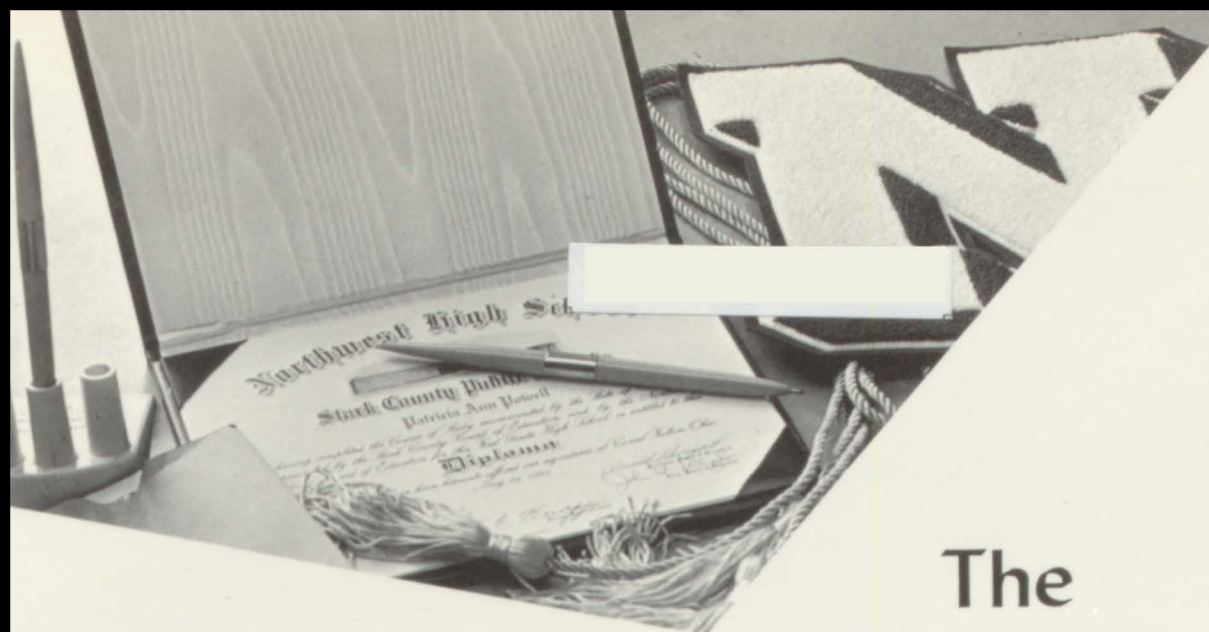

FOREWORD

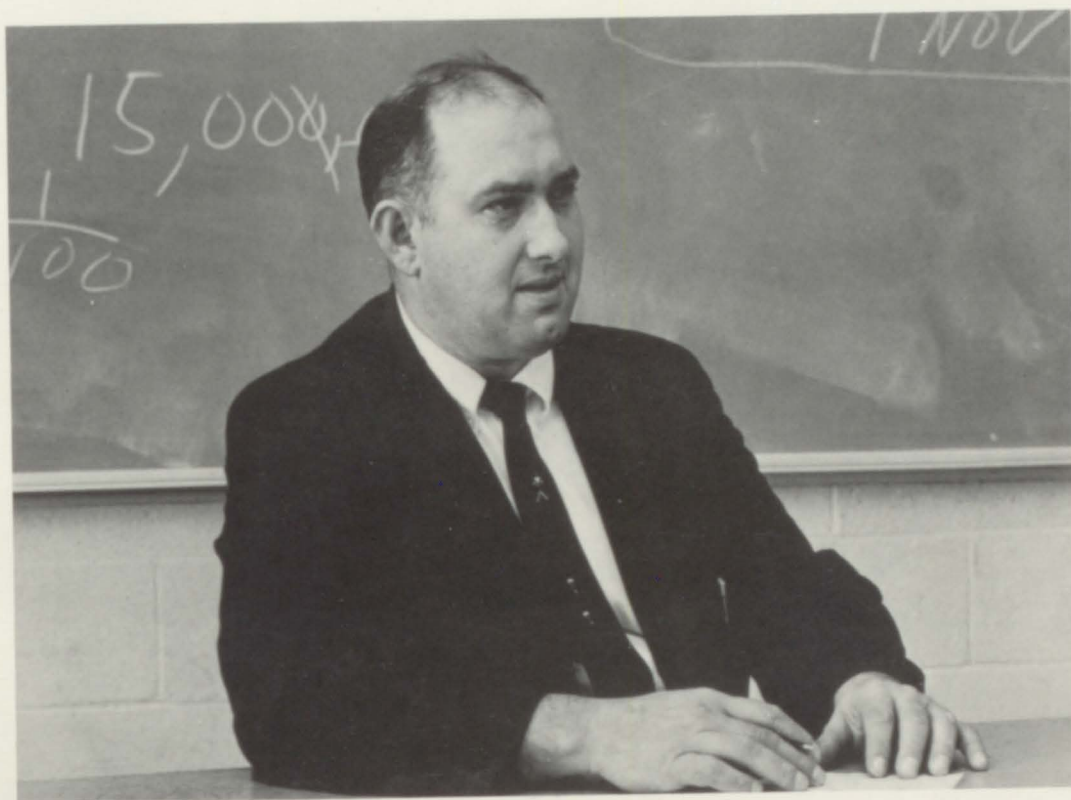
Northwest High, our love will never end,
