Foreword

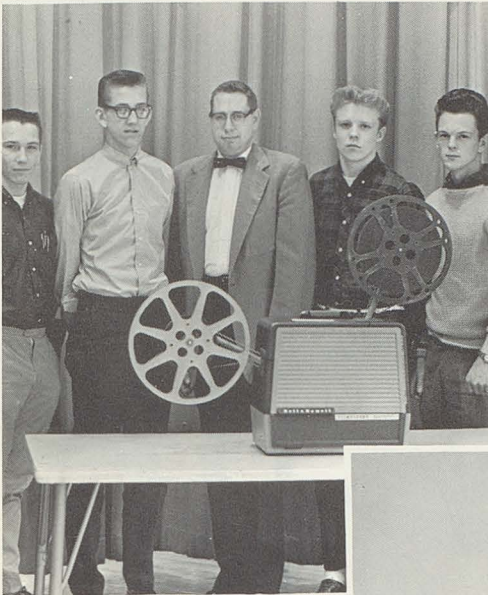
