A TIME FOR GOOD BYES



TOM HEALEY

Tom was born in Wellsville, Ohio on December 3, 1921. Growing up in this Ohio River town set the example of hard work in young Tom. Graduating in 1940 from Wellsville High School, Tom started working in the pottery plants of Wellsville and East Liverpool for the next two years until May of 1942 when he enlisted in the U.S. Navy. Tom spent the next four years serving his country during the Second World War in the South Pacific serving on two different destroyers. Tom was married to his high school sweetheart, Dorothy Scott, on October 31, 1945 in Wellsville. Tom continued his tenure with Uncle Sam until November of 1946 when he was honorably discharged.

Tom and Dorothy had their first of eight children within a couple of years and now have in addition to the four children still at home, Alice, Fritz, Suzie and Rachel, children living in California (John), Massachusetts (Scott), Texas (Max), and North Carolina (Chris). Tom entered Kent State in 1947, graduating 1950 and returned to his Alma Mater, Wellsville High School for the next seven years (five of which he served as head basketball coach.) Tom left the state for one year (going to Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania) to become their head basketball coach and teacher. He was summoned to Canal Fulton and Northwest High School in 1958 as social studies teacher, driver education teacher and head basketball coach. Tom left Northwest for three years (traveling all the way to North Canton) but couldn't stay away from good-old Northwest. In 1968, he once again served as head coach and faculty manager at Northwest! In 1971, Tom was appointed the school's first athletic director and has served in that capacity ever since.

Tom says his coaching highlight came in the 1960-61 basketball season when his Northwest squad made it all the way to the regional tournament where they wer beaten by the eventual state runner-up. The teams final record was an outstanding 21-3.






Nick was born on March 5, 1932 in Grant Town, West Virginia to immigrant parents from Spain. Nick attended school in Rivesville and Fairmont, West Virginia and graduated from Riversville High School in 1950. He entered the U.S. Air Force in 1951 and served for the next four years with Uncle Samtwo years in Libya. Upon his discharge in 1055, he entered Fairmont State College in Fairmont, West Virginia and graduated in 1958 with a degree in journalism and English. While enrolled at Fairmont, he met Nancy Belt whom he married on August 1, 1959. Nick and Nancy both obtained jobs in the Sandy Valley School system in the 1959-1960 school year where Nick taught English and Spanish and was the advisor to several clubs (school play, yearbook, etc.). After



one year at Sandy Valley, Nick and Nancy came to Northwest Local Schools in Canal Fulton where Nick once again taught Spanish and English. Their first child, Cathy, was born while in Canal Fulton, and a couple of years later, son John came along. Nick wanted to test the market in other areas and he and his family moved to Frederick, Maryland for one year where he and Nancy both taught. Nick returned to Northwest in 1965 where he and Nancy have been ever since. Nick has been principal at Clinton Elementary, W.S. Stinson, Norhtwest Intermediate and Northwest High School (also serving as assistant principal there). During this past year, Nick taught "Methods For Student Teaching" at Malone College in Canton



Nick got very actively involved in the North Central Association-school accreditation system while at Northwest High School. He has served as co-chairman on numerous onsite evaluations of other area high schools and the past several years has been named to the position of "area coordinator" of the North Central Association Northeastern-Ohio regions. Nick has been quite actively involved in the Rotary Club of Canal Fulton and has been instrumental in helping them assert themselves as the academic booster club of Northwest High School.

The yearbook staff would like to thank Mr. Corral for all of his support and bid a fond farewell to both Mr. Corral and Mr. Healey.






FOREIGN EXCHANGE








TEAM EFFORT
